Pool Noodle Horse



Have fun prancing and galloping!



MATERIALS:

POOL NOODLE

ELECTRICAL TAPE

RIBBON

SCISSORS

HOT GLUE GUN &
GLUE STICKS (ADULT SUPER-VISION REQUIRED)

FELT (BLACK, WHITE & ANOTHER COLOR)

STYROFOAM BALL

- Bend the end of the noodle. Wrap electrical tape around it to hold it in place.
- Hot glue a piece of ribbon over the tape for the bridle. Cut another piece of ribbon for the reins. Hot glue each end over bridle ribbon.
- Cut a narrow rectangle of black felt for the ears. Push it through the fold. Attach with hot glue on each side. Cut the ends into ear shapes.
- Cut a large rectangle out of colored felt.
 Cut strips in from all four sides to make
 fringe. Put hot glue down the center of
 the felt. Glue it to the horse's head and
 neck. Trim the fringe around the ears.
- Cut two circles out of black felt. Cut two small circles out of white felt. Hot glue the white circles to the black circles.
- Cut the styrofoam ball in half. Hot glue a black circle to the round side of each half. Hot glue the halves to the noodle for the eyes. Let the glue dry.
